A Cicada Travelogue: 8 Countries, 5 Continents and 1500 (3000?) Species

Cicada habitats, songs and behaviors will be demonstrated via slides and videos, along with an overview of family-level cicada systematics. Behaviors demonstrated include butt-wagging, wing buzzing, nocturnal singing, aggressive mimicry and jealousy. Family-level systematics will be discussed as inferred from hybridization, taxonomy and biogeographic distributions.
